Laird A. Lile reappointed to Florida Courts Technology Commission by Florida Supreme Court

NAPLES, Fla. (July 17, 2013) – Laird A. Lile, a wills, trusts and estates attorney in Naples, has been reappointed to the Florida Courts Technology Commission by Chief Justice Ricky Polston. Lile, whose appointment continues through June 2016, was first appointed in 2010 and is one of only three practicing attorneys on the 25-member commission.

The Florida Courts Technology Commission was established as a permanent judicial branch commission to oversee, manage and direct the development and use of technology within the judicial branch under the direction of the Florida Supreme Court.

The commission's membership includes county and appellate court judges; court administrators and technology officers; clerks of court for several Florida counties and judicial districts; and three practicing attorneys.

An elected member of the Board of Governors for The Florida Bar, Lile is certified as a Wills, Trusts and Estates lawyer, is a Fellow in the American College of Trust and Estate Counsel and serves on its Board of Regents. He is past chair of The Florida Bar's Real Property, Probate and Trust Law Section, has been included in Woodward/White's The Best Lawyers in America since 1995 and was named to Florida Trend's Legal Elite Hall of Fame in 2010.
