Laird A. Lile provides legislative update to CCBA Trust and Estate Section

NAPLES, Fla. (May 13, 2015) – Laird A. Lile, a board-certified wills, trusts and estates attorney in Naples, recently provided an overview of the 2015 Florida legislative session to the Trust and Estate Section of the Collier County Bar Association.

Lile reviewed legislation passed during the session related to guardianships, protection of the developmentally disabled, estates and tax apportionment, healthcare surrogates, and electronic notice of trust accounts.

Lile was appointed in 2013 by the chief justice to a second three-year term on the Supreme Court's Florida Courts Technology Commission, which is overseeing the technological overhaul of the state's courts. He recently was appointed by Gov. Rick Scott to the Second District Court of Appeal Judicial Nominating Commission and elected vice chair by his fellow commissioners.

Lile is past chair of the Bar's 9,000-member Real Property, Probate & Trust Law Section. An elected member of the Board of Regents, past state chair and a fellow in the American College of Trust and Estate Counsel, Lile has been included in Woodward/White's The Best Lawyers in America for 20 consecutive years. He is recognized as one of Florida's 100 Top Super Lawyers and was named to Florida Trend's Legal Elite Hall of Fame in 2011.
