Appointed by the Florida Supreme Court to its Judicial Management Council and to a third term on the Florida Courts Technology Commission, Lile also is a member of the Second District Court of Appeal Judicial Nominating Commission.

Lile is past chair of the Bar’s 10,800-member Real Property, Probate & Trust Law Section. An elected member of the Board of Regents, past state chair and a Fellow in the American College of Trust and Estate Counsel, Lile was inducted into Florida Trend’s Legal Elite Hall of Fame in 2010. He recently was named to Best Lawyers in America for the 23rd consecutive year.
