**Laird A. Lile named to COVID-19 Pandemic Recovery Task Force**

NAPLES, Fla. (Aug. 25, 2020) – Laird A. Lile, a board-certified wills, trusts and estates attorney in Naples, has been named by The Florida Bar Board of Governors to the COVID-19 Pandemic Recovery Task Force.

Chaired by Florida Bar President-Elect Michael Tanner, the task force will study the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on Florida’s legal profession, identify key issues facing citizens of Florida and Florida Bar members, and advise The Florida Bar president and executive director on how to best address these key issues.

Lile, a Top 10 Florida Super Lawyer, is serving his eighth consecutive term on the Board of Governors for The Florida Bar. He is one of two governors elected by members to represent the 20th Judicial Circuit, which includes Collier, Lee, Charlotte, Hendry and Glades counties.

Appointed by the Florida Supreme Court to the Task Force on the Distribution of IOTA Funds, a second term on the Judicial Management Council, and a third term on the Florida Courts Technology Commission, Lile is past chair of the Second District Court of Appeal Nominating Commission. He is a past chair of the Bar’s 10,800-member Real Property, Probate & Trust Law Section, and a Fellow and past state Bar chair in the American College of Trust and Estate Counsel. Lile was inducted into Florida Trend’s Legal Elite Hall of Fame in 2010. He recently was named a second time to Florida Trend’s 500 Most Influential Business Leaders in Florida.
